



Glanmore National Historic Site – EXTERIOR RESTORATION

Glanmore National Historic Site has completed an extensive Exterior Restoration Project. The mansard roof system, intricate woodwork and cast-iron cresting were all restored. The porches, ornamental veranda, and service walkway were reproduced and the original 4 colour paint scheme was reinstated. Landscaping restored the original appearance of the grounds. Major funding for the Exterior Restoration Project was provided by the Department of Canadian Heritage and the Salaman Bequest. Future restoration projects will focus on the interior of Glanmore.
