



## **GLANMORE NATIONAL HISTORIC SITE**

### **STATEMENT OF PURPOSE**

Glanmore National Historic Site, an 1883 restored home originally established in 1971, is organized under the Corporation of the City of Belleville as per the Minister's Restructuring Order of January 1, 1998.

The Museum's purpose is to:

- Collect, preserve, research, exhibit and interpret objects that best serve to illustrate the history of the Belleville region;
- Collect, preserve, research, exhibit and interpret objects that best serve to depict the lifestyle of Glanmore's original residents J.P.C. and Harriet Phillips;
- Collect, preserve, research, exhibit and interpret the commemorative elements associated with Glanmore's designation as a site of national historic significance.
