A boil water advisory remains in effect for the area which includes all properties on Elgin Street, Tripp Avenue, Pepper Avenue, Faraday Gardens, Butler Street, Lake Court and Moira Street West in the vicinity of Elgin Street and Butler Streets.

Recent water sample results have shown the water may be unsatisfactory for drinking. Residents in the affected area are advised to continue to boil water before consumption or to use bottled water until further notice.

The earliest possible date the boil water advisory could be lifted is Friday, July 23rd, 2010. The public will be notified through a media release as soon as the boil water advisory is no longer required.
