### **HELMETS ARE STRONGLY RECOMMENDED FOR EVERYONE ON THE ICE**

- No carrying of children is permitted
- No strollers, wagons, toboggans, etc. are permitted on the ice
- No sitting or climbing over the boards

# Public Swimming 2011-2012

## PUBLIC SWIMMING RULES OF CONDUCT:

- All participants who are not toilet trained must wear a plastic pant over or under their bathing suit or wear a swim diaper to prevent fouling of the pool.
- NO DISPOSABLE DIAPERS ALLOWED.
- ALL NON-SWIMMERS must remain in the shallow end.
- Flotation devices are not allowed in the deep end.
- The City of Belleville is committed to the safety of our swimmers. Any child swimming alone must be a minimum of 10 years of age.

## Supervision to Swimmer Ratios will be as follows:

- A ratio of 1 participating adult (16 years or older): 2 children will be enforced for ALL children less than 6 years and all non-swimmers under the age of 10.
- A ratio of 1 participating adult: 8 children will be permitted for larger groups provided lifejackets are worn by all non-swimmers (under the age of 10) in their care.
- The participating adult must provide direct supervision within arms reach.

- For children between the ages of 6-9, that are able to pass our swim test (2-widths), they may participate alone provided a supervising adult remains in the pool area.
