Notice of Public Meeting

Official Plan Amendment, Zoning By-Law Amendment, and Draft Plan of Subdivision Applications

174 Maitland Drive, Belleville, ON File No.: B-50-3-33, B-77-1124, & 12T-20002 City Council Planning Advisory Committee Monday, December 7th, 2020 at 5:30 P.M.

Due to the ongoing COVID-19 situation, the City of Belleville is now conducting all committee meetings virtually. Members of the public will still have the ability to provide input and watch meeting proceedings digitally.

A Public Meeting, as noted above, will be held on December 7, 2020 at 5:30 P.M. to consider amendments to the Official Plan and Zoning By-law 3014, as amended and a Draft Plan of Subdivision application for a property located west of Highway 62 and on the south side of Maitland Drive, which is known municipally as 174 Maitland Drive.

The subject land has approximately 220 metres of frontage on Maitland Drive. Applications have been submitted to amend the Official Plan, amend Zoning By-Law 3014, and approve Draft Plan of Subdivision 12T-20002. The applications propose to amend the Official Plan land use designation from "Commercial" to "Residential" and rezone the lands from Development (D-r) Zone to the following zones:

- Low Density Residential (R1-23) Zone to permit 36 single-detached dwellings;
- High Density Residential (R4-2) Zone to permit 23 townhome dwelling units;
- High Density Residential (R4) Zone with special provisions to permit 38 back-to-back townhome units, and relief to the zone provisions for minimum front yard, minimum interior side yard, minimum rear yard, maximum lot coverage, minimum parking requirement, minimum parking space width, and to permit parking in the front yard;
- Community Facility (CF-9) Zone to permit a stormwater pond; and
- Community Facility (CF-10) Zone to permit recreational open space.

The Existing Official Plan Designation Map is shown on APPENDIX 1 and the Existing

Zoning Map is shown on APPENDIX 2 which are attached.

As per the requirements of the Planning Act, these applications are confirmed to be complete. Any supporting documents submitted with the applications are available for review online at belleville.ca/DevelopmentApplications.

Purpose of the Meeting:

The initial public meeting is held in accordance with the requirements of the Planning Act. The purpose of this meeting is for Committee Members to formally hear and receive public comments. The intent of this statutory public planning meeting is to receive public feedback and incorporate it into a recommendation report from Staff. No decision will be made during this meeting.

How to watch a meeting:

All committee meetings will be streamed live, available on the Belleville City Hall YouTube channel (<u>youtube.com/BellevilleCityHall</u>). The video will also be posted online following the meeting in the event you were unable to watch it live at the time it occurred.

How to participate in a meeting:

Written comments (via email or in writing) before a meeting

Members of the public will also be able to participate in committee meetings through Zoom. Interested residents can register by emailing planning@belleville.ca with their name, phone number, and the agenda item(s) they wish to speak to, or by calling 613-967-3288 and leaving a message with their name, phone number, and the agenda item(s) they wish to speak to. Those who have registered will be provided with the Zoom meeting information prior to the meeting date. Registration will close at 4 p.m. Thursday, December 3, 2020.

To participate in a meeting via telephone, members of the public must register by calling 613-967-3288 and leave a message with their name, phone number and the agenda item(s) they wish to speak to; City staff will then contact the member of the public to confirm their participation and provide meeting details. Registration will close at 4 p.m. Thursday, December 3, 2020.

How to provide comments and/or ask a question during the meeting:

Registered members of the public will be able to provide comments and ask questions during virtual public meetings in a similar manner as in-person public meetings. The Chair of the meeting will announce each registered member when it is their turn to speak. Each registered member will be allocated five (5) minutes to provide comments and/or questions regarding the applications.

How to submit comments after a meeting:

If you missed the live meeting, had technical issues, or prefer to submit comments following the public meeting, you may email your comments to planning@belleville.ca. The City encourages these comments to be submitted within seven (7) days of the meeting so that the comments can be reviewed by Planning Staff before they prepare a final recommendation report.

How to be notified of the decision:

If you wish to be notified of the decision of the City of Belleville or Belleville Planning Advisory Committee in respect of these applications, you must submit a <u>written</u> request to Matt MacDonald, Secretary, Planning Advisory Committee by mail at: Belleville City Hall, 169 Front Street, Belleville, K8N 2Y8, or by email at: <u>mtmacdonald@belleville.ca</u>.

How to appeal the decision:

If a person or public body would otherwise have an ability to appeal the decision of the City of Belleville to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal but the person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the City of Belleville before the by-law is passed, the person or public body is <u>not</u> entitled to appeal the decision and that person or public body may <u>not</u> be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal unless, in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to do so. Please be further advised that written submissions received prior to the public meeting may be made available to the Applicant.


