## Loyalist (West) Secondary Plan Update

The City of Belleville is currently undertaking an Update to the Loyalist (West) Secondary Plan, and will hold an in-person Public Information Centre (PIC). Please join us for this opportunity to discuss and provide your feedback on the Loyalist (West) Secondary Plan Area's draft land use concept, which was informed by the work and consultation that has been completed to date. Feedback received will help the project team solidify the land use concept and plan, as well as plans for phasing of development and implementation.

## The Public Information Centre (PIC) will be held on Thursday, September 22, 2022 from 5:00 P.M. to 7:00 P.M. at Loyalist College (376 Wallbridge-Loyalist Road).

The Loyalist (West) Secondary Plan area encompasses approximately 950 hectares of land located east of Wallbridge Loyalist Road, south of Highway 401 and north of the Bay of Quinte. The Loyalist Secondary Plan (LSP) was adopted by City Council in 2010, and provides the framework for the current and future development of the Loyalist (West) Secondary Plan Area. An Update to this Plan is an important next step in planning for the future of the City.

The session will be held in the dining hall and will include a short presentation by the project team, followed by interactive activities for the public to provide input to the draft land use concept.
